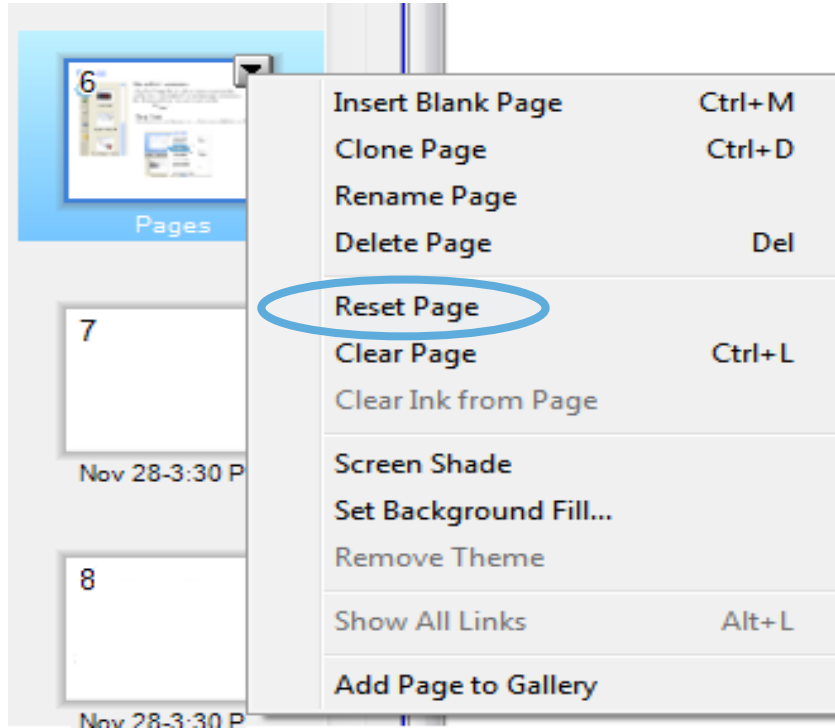
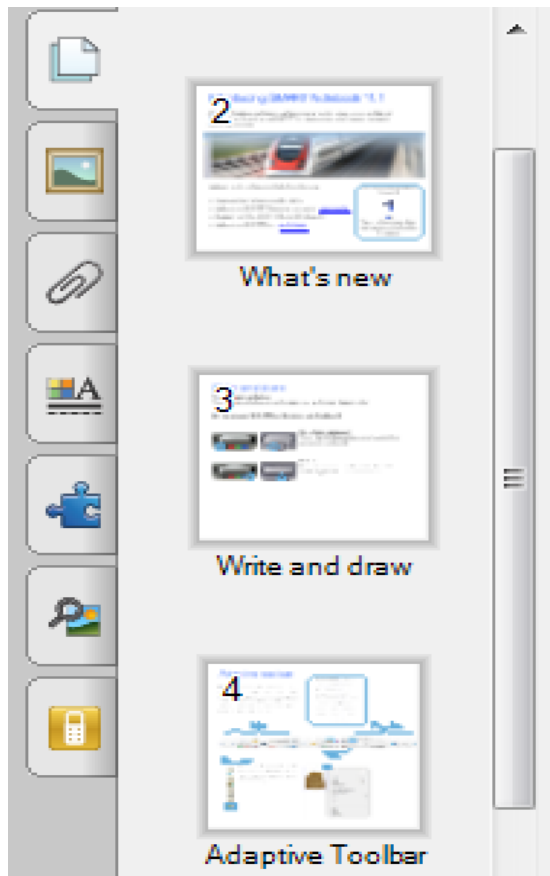


See and sort your pages

Use the **Page Sorter** tab to jump to a page by selecting its thumbnail, or reorganize your pages by dragging them into a different order.

Reset Page

Easily reset your page to its **last saved state**, without reopening your lesson file.



Gallery content

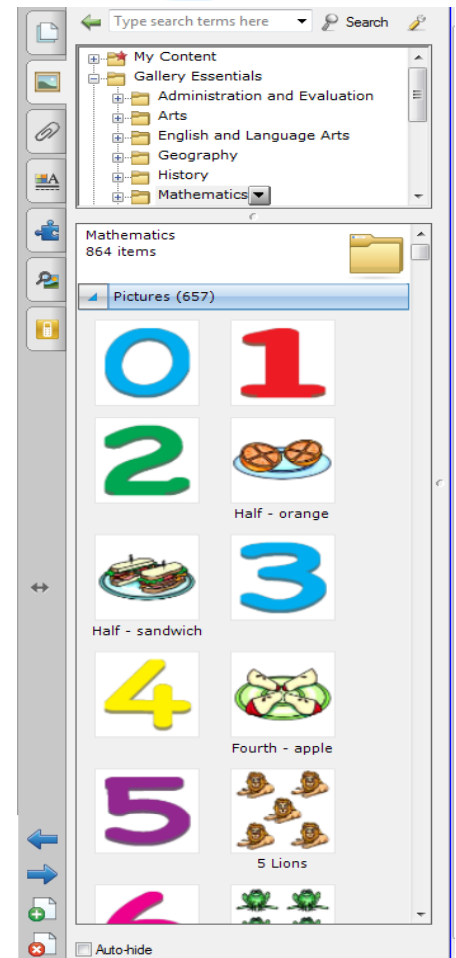
Find content in the Gallery

Actions Panel

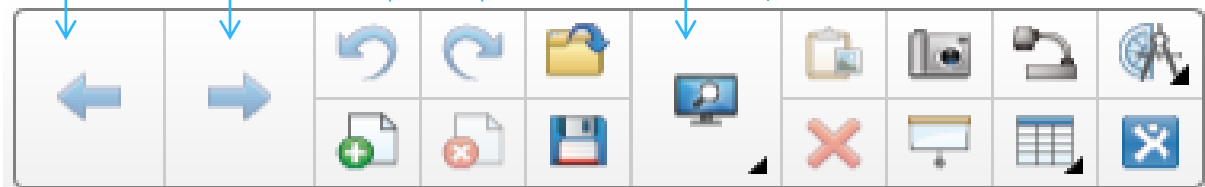
This switches to Full Screen mode. This is important for using the SmartBoard with a class. It closes out all of the editing toolbars and panels.

Undo & Redo

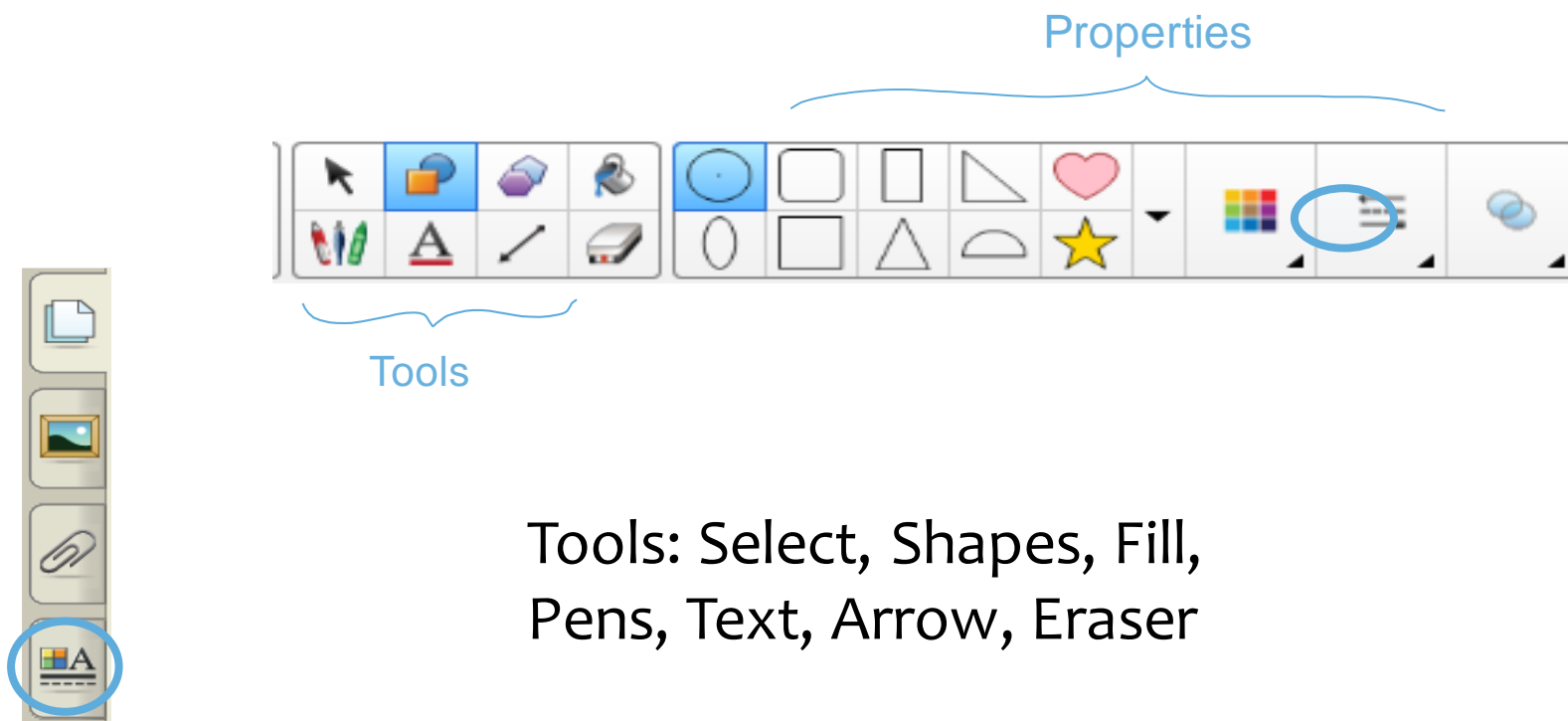
These buttons insert different types of objects to your page.



Actions

Adaptive toolbar

The toolbar provides shortcuts to commonly used actions, tools and properties. When you use the Select tool to select an object in the work area, its properties appear to the right of the tools group.

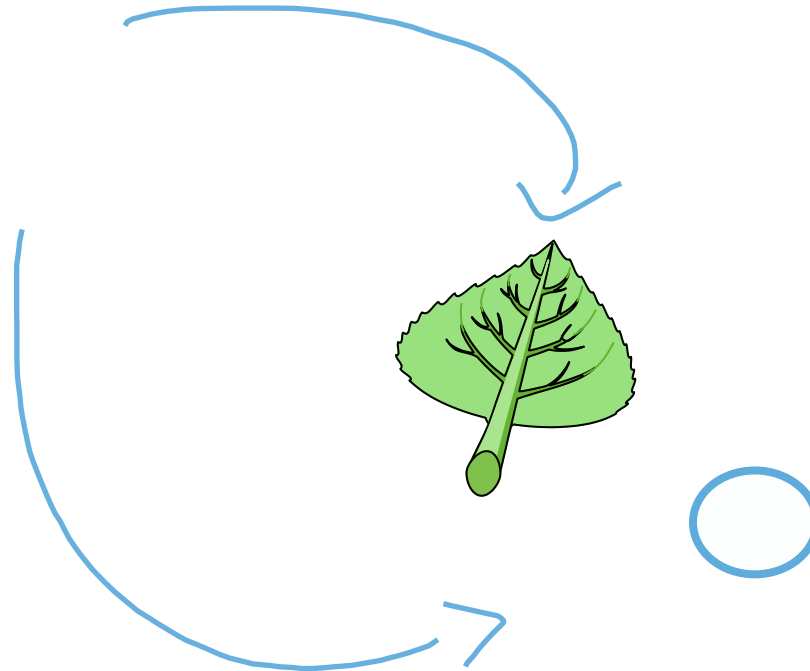


Objects

Text objects

- Add text: Click the **Text** button on the toolbar, and then click the work area to create a text box. Start typing.
- You can format text using the buttons in the toolbar or the options in the Properties tab or the Format menu.
- Edit text: Double-click the text box to edit text.
- Resizing the text box: Drag the white handle to adjust the length of the text box and reflow the text inside.

1. After you preview the file, click Download to save the file.

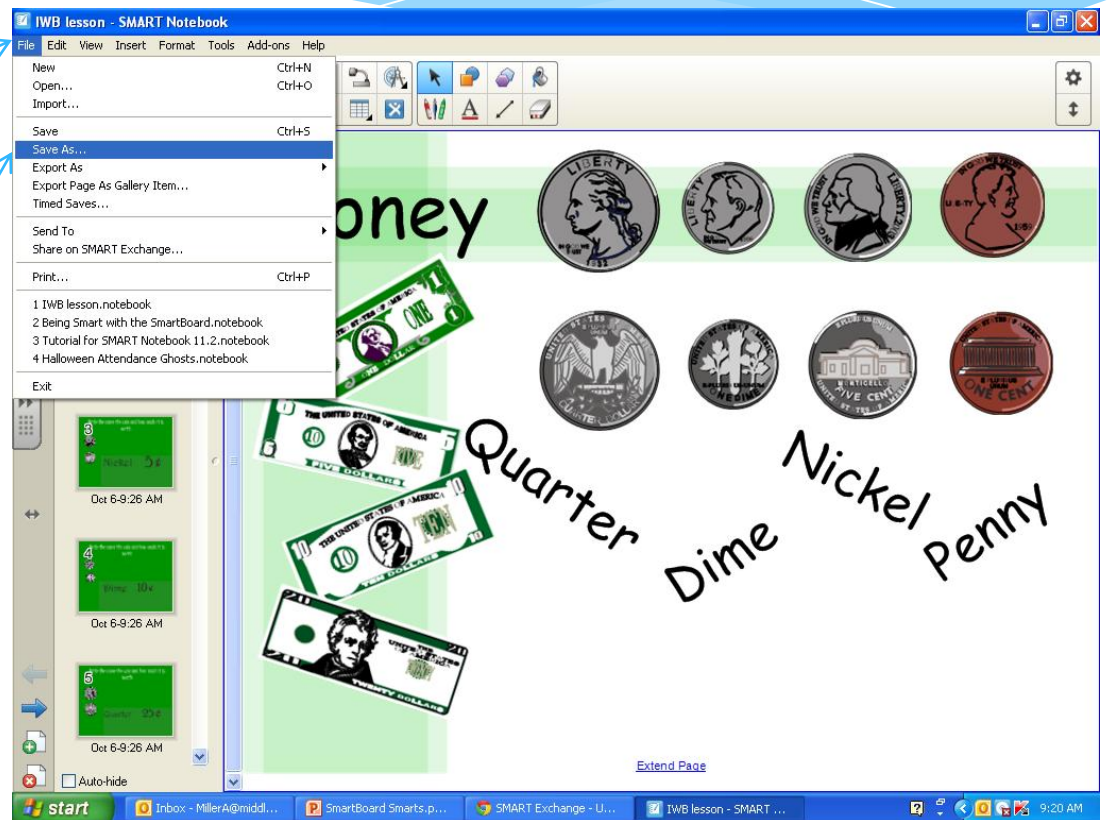

3. Click the arrow and select Open from the menu.

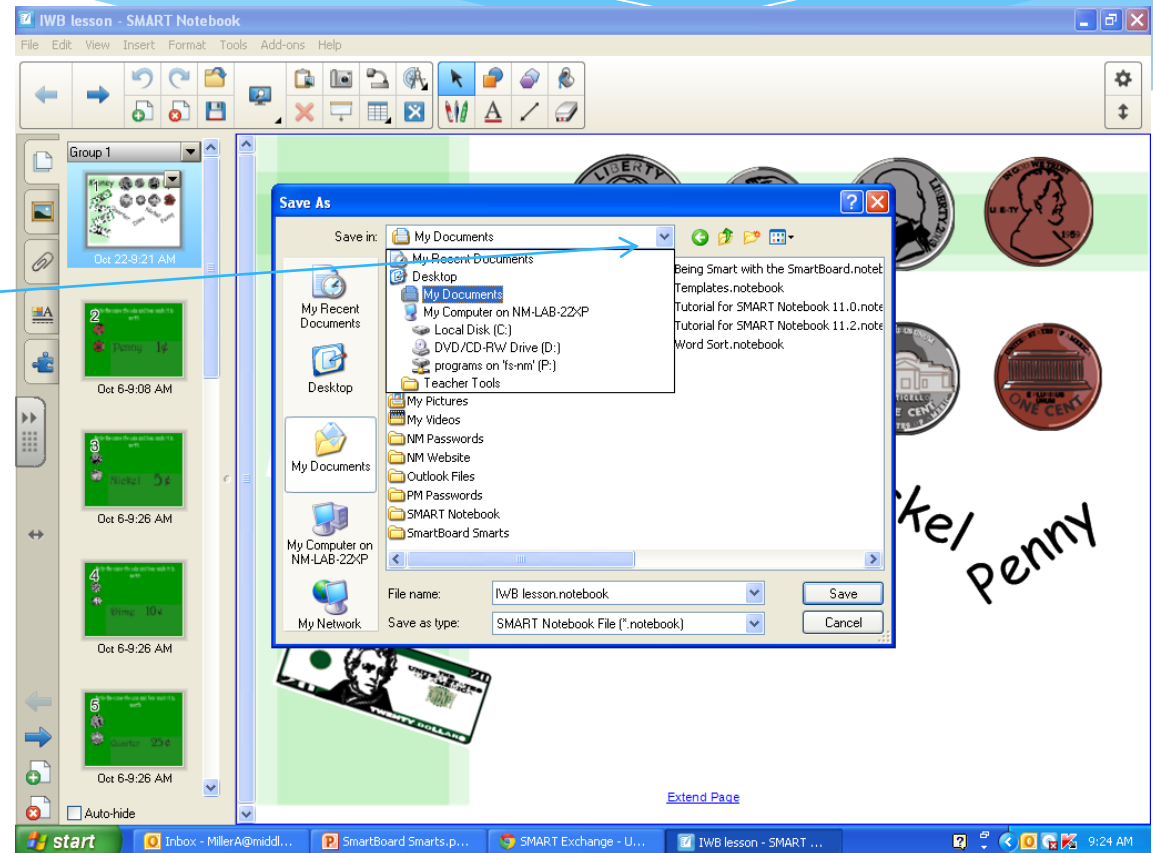
Save the file

Choose where the file is saved to. Click the arrow . It is automatically placed in your downloads. Choose My Documents and rename the file to something that will help you find the file again.

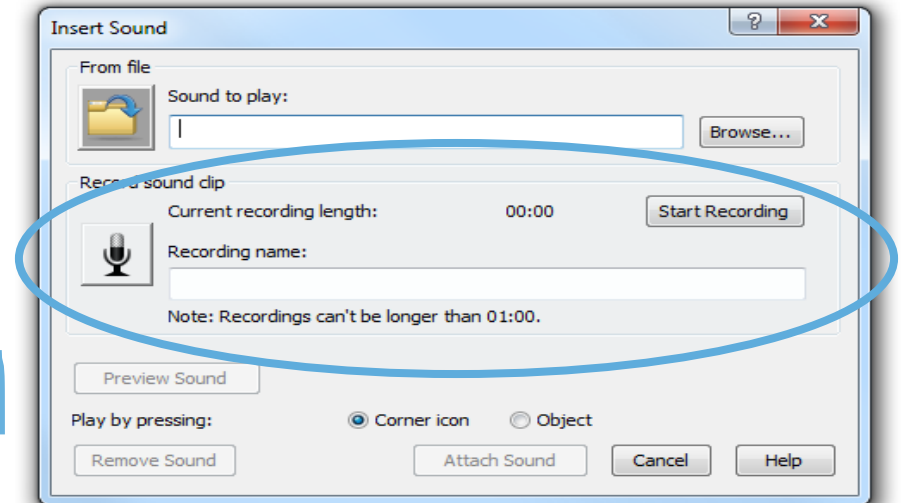
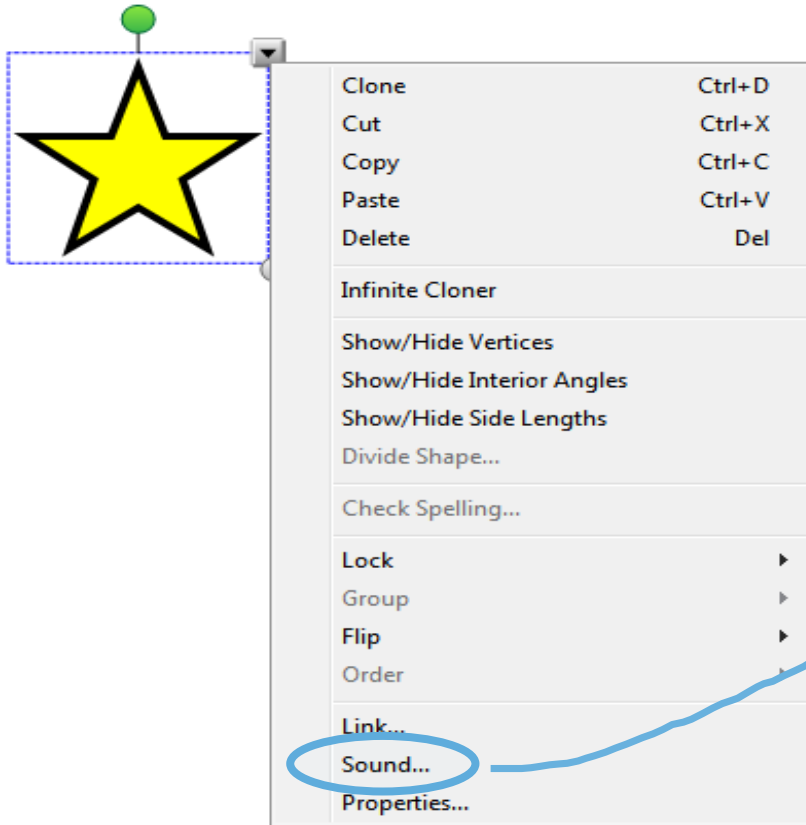

Activity Builder

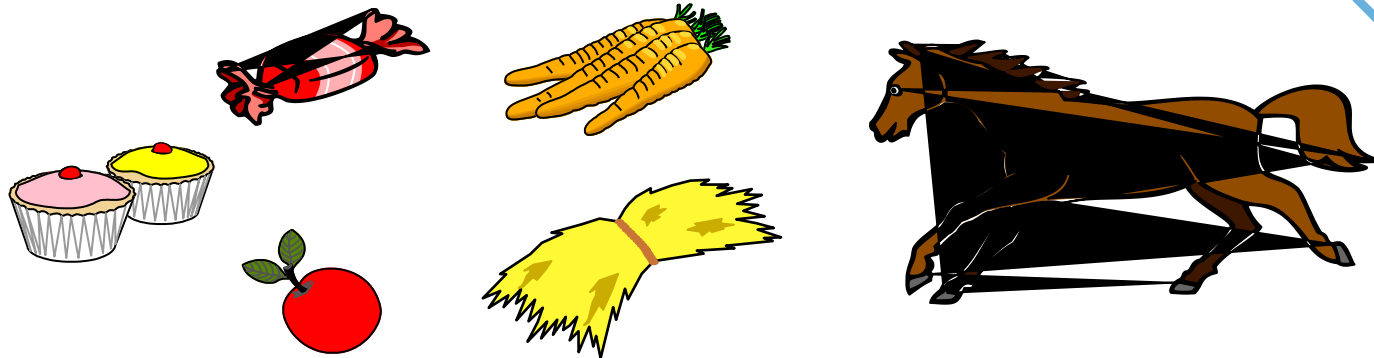
Create interactive lesson activities easily by using the Activity Builder. To start, click the **Add-ons** tab, and then click the **Activity Builder** thumbnail.

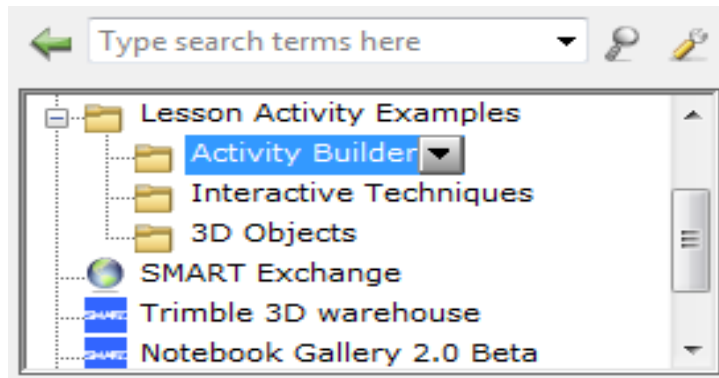


What do horses eat?

Drag and drop foods over the horse to feed it.

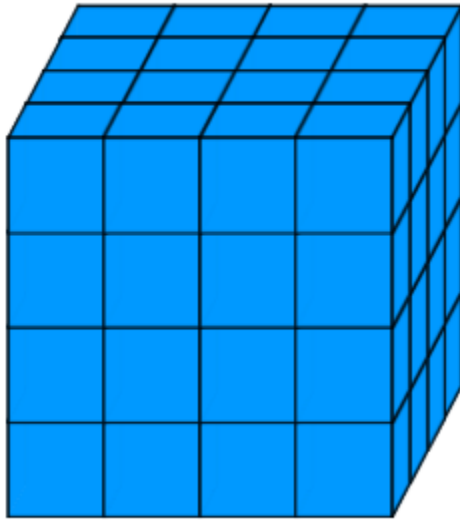

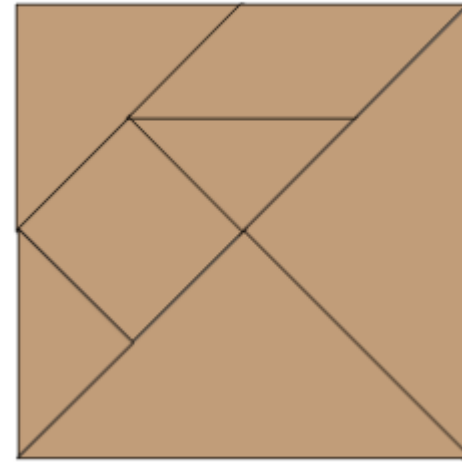

Cube – Grid

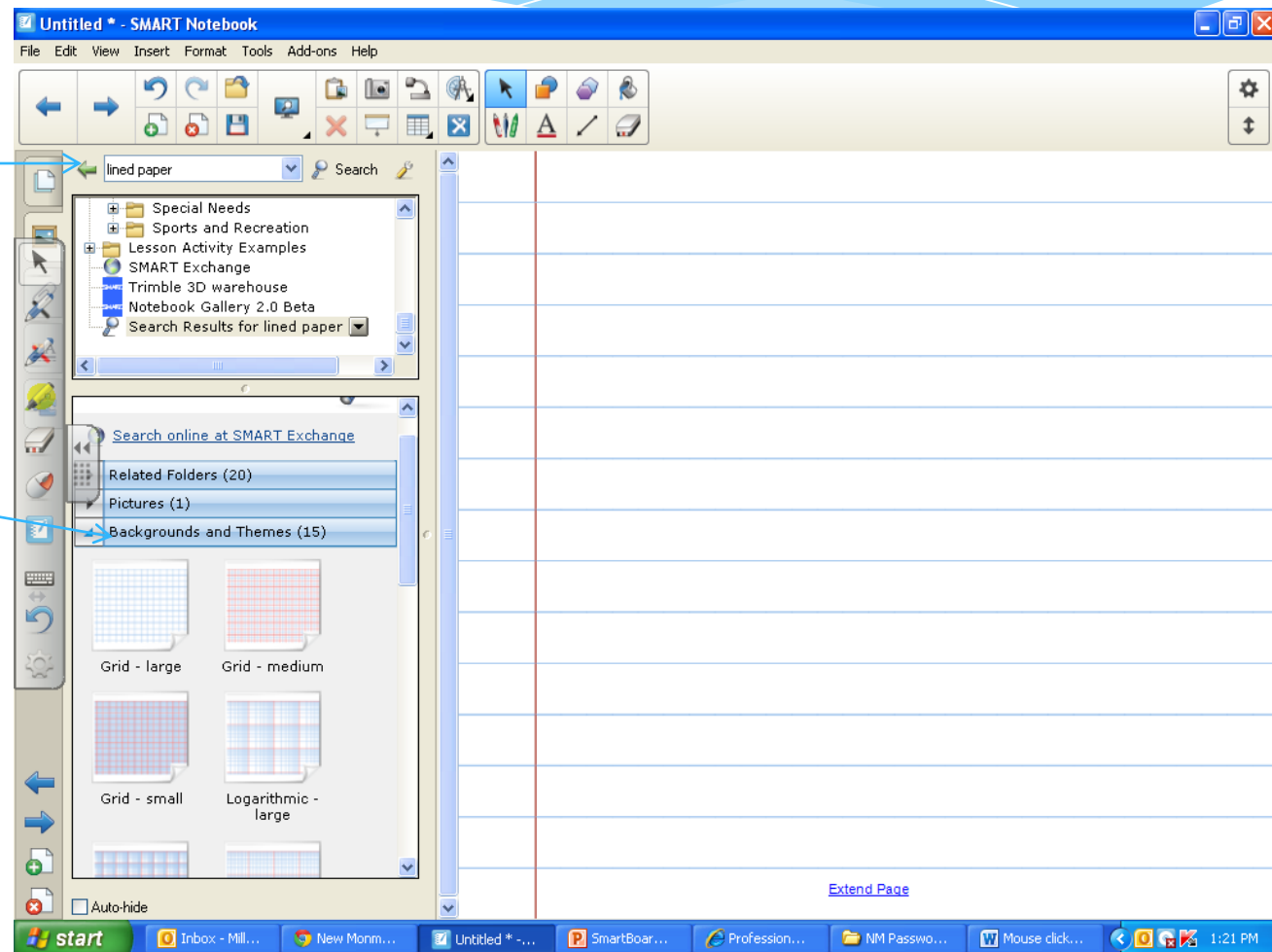


Tangram - full

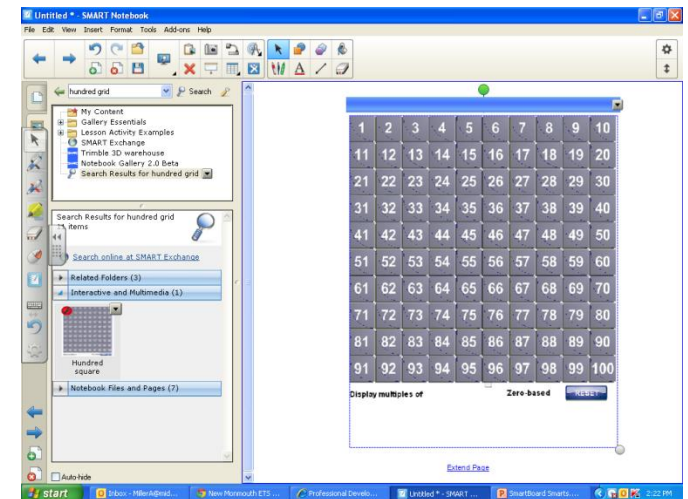
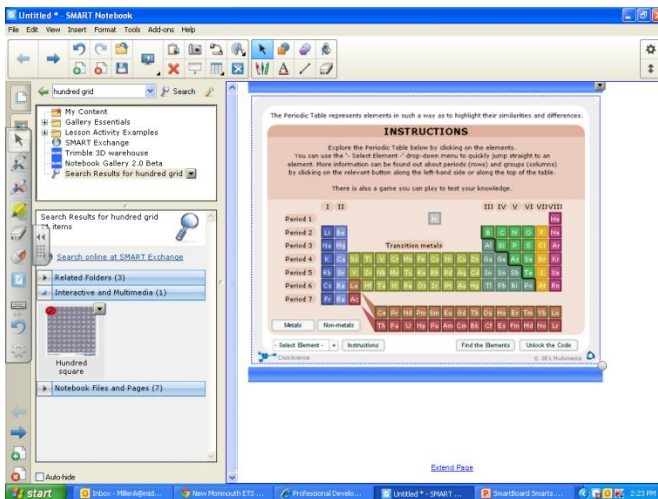
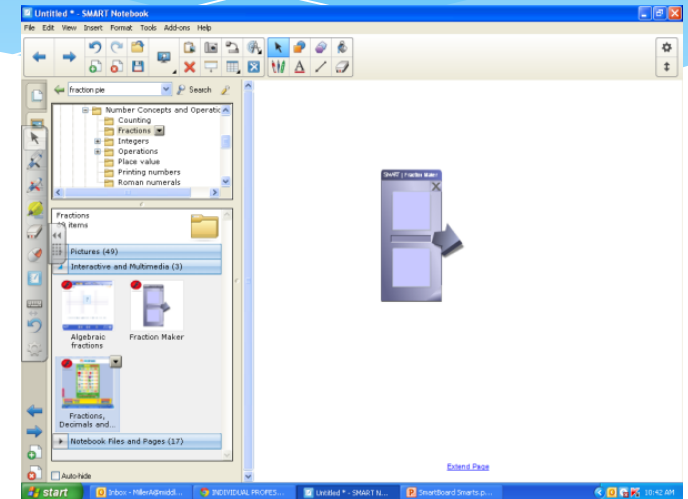
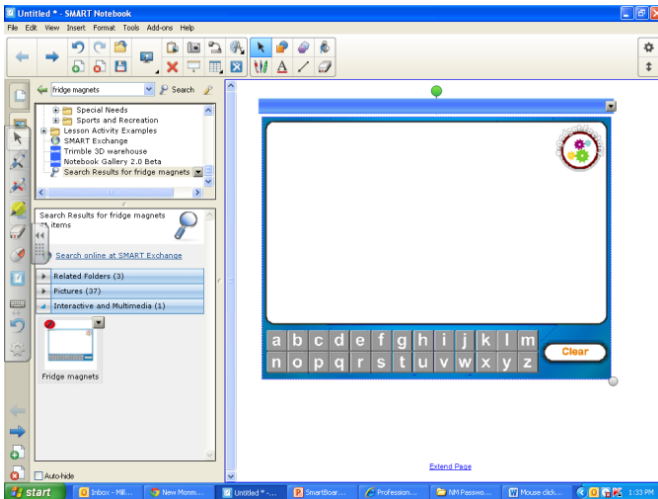
Interactive Backgrounds



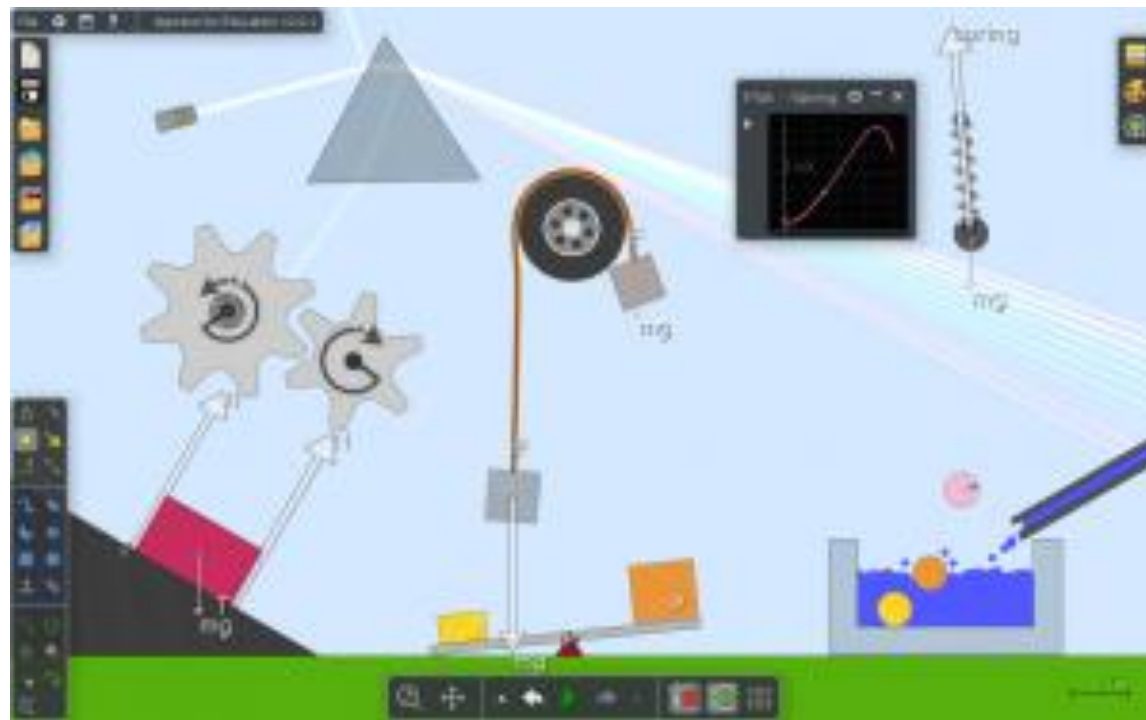
